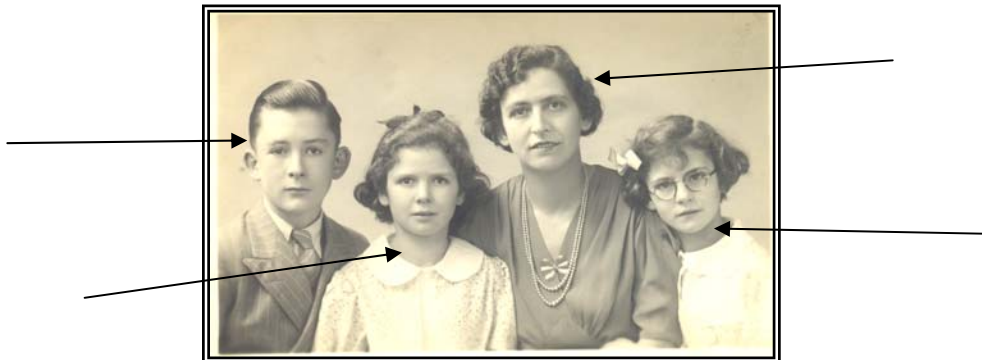

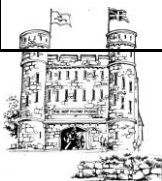
4. Look at Source D. In the space provided explain what the lady is doing - there is a clue in the story of the young girl.

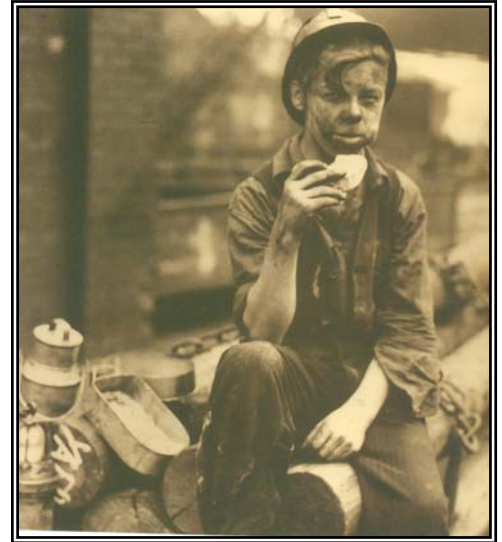
The small boy is sitting on his suitcase. In the box list the things YOU would need for a long visit somewhere. The case or bag is the size of about two normal school back-packs.
