

DORSET REGIMENT GALLIPOLI ROLL OF HONOUR

Officers:

BOLES, Lieutenant Noel Henry 2nd Bn. Refer to Royal Naval Air Service

CARUTHERS-LITTLE, Captain Arthur William Palling 5th Bn.

He was the son of Colonel 3. C. Caruthers-Little of Stroud, Gloucestershire. Husband of Olive Murray (née Lannoy) Caruthers-Little of Charlton Kings, Cheltenham, Glos. On Aug. 7, 1915, he was shot in the heart by a Turkish sniper, while accompanying Lt. Col. Hannay to the rear from Hill 28, Suvia, to deliver a report. He was 30 years old. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

EASON, Lieutenant Sampson 5th Bn.

Born Apr. 20, 1876, at Crewkerne, Somerset, the youngest son of Robert Eason, farmer, and Ellen (née Marks) Eason of Crewkerne. Husband of Mabel Ellen (née Adams) Eason (married Dec. 5, 1907, at St. Simon's Church, Southsea, Hampshire (they had no children). He enlisted as a Private in The Dorsetshire Regt. on Mar. 7, 1893, and served with the regiment in India and the Boer War (Queen's South Africa Medal w/2 clasps). From 1909 to 1914 he served as Colour Sergeant with "H" Company, 4th Bn. (T.F.) at Blandford, and on Mar. 6, 1914, he was discharged from the army with that rank. Having served with the colours for 21 years, he had been awarded the Army Long Service and Good Conduct Medal. Following his discharge, he went to live near Dorchester. On the outbreak of war in Aug. 1914 he volunteered for active service, and was appointed Company Sergeant Major with the 5th Dorsets. He was later offered a commission, and was gazetted Lieutenant in his battalion on Mar. 6, 1915. He was shot in the head and killed while directing his troops on Aug. 7, 1915, aged 39 years. It is evident from the following reports that Lieut. Eason was buried, however, following the reoccupation of the Gallipoli peninsula in 1919, his grave was unable to be located by the Imperial (later Commonwealth) War Graves Commission. Thus, he is today commemorated on the Helles Memorial. (Photo in de Ruvigny's Bcll of Honour. Vol. I, page 122.)

In de Ruvigny's Roll of Honour, Vol. I (page 122), Brigadier General (formerly Lieutenant Colonel) E.C. Hannay is quoted as reporting:

"Lieut. Eason was shot through the head, dying shortly after, on the 7th instant at Suvla Bay, about a quarter-of-an-hour after he landed. It was about 4 a.m. and dark at the time; I was within two yards of him at the time. He never spoke after he fell."

In the same source, and unnamed Sergeant is quoted as reporting:

"It was the duty of Mr. Eason and myself to direct the men to their proper companies as they came ashore in the dark. About half-an-hour after landing, I was tailcuing to Mr. Eason, and he had only left me two or three seconds when the Colonel called me to come to him and pick somebody up. I did, and when I turned him over I found it was Mr. Eason. Everything was done for him that could be done, but he did not speak. The doctor was with him almost at once. He died doing his duty, which he always did, and was always considered a good N.C.O. and afterwards a good officer, and we were very sorry to lose him."

An unnamed officer is also quoted:

"I always looked on him as a friend from whom I could get advice and help in my work. The last time I saw him, which was on the destroyer before we landed, he did me a good turn which I shall not forget. Earlier in the evening I, being orderly officer, had to see to the issuing out of hot coffee to the men, and it was a long job, as the space is very cramped. Later in the evening there was an issue of rum to be served out. It really fell to my lot to superintend this, but your husband, with his usual kindness of heart, relieved me of it. I am sorry to say I was not near him at the end. It was before we had got off the beach".

GEORGE, 2nd Lieutenant Frank William "A" Company, 5th Bn.

Son of William and Angelina George of Bere Regis, Wareham, Dorset. Mentioned in Despatches. Just after beginning the advance against the Turkish trenches running south from Hetman

Chair, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, he was killed by Turkish shrapnel. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

LE MARCHANT, Captain Henry Neville Commanding, "C" Company, 5th Bn.

During the assault on Kiretch Tepe Sin, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915, he was hit in the body by a ricochet. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

LESLIE, Major Richard Fitzgerald William Ferris 5th Bn.

He was educated at Cheltenham College. In 1889 he was gazetted 2nd Lieutenant in the Royal Scots Fusiliers, and in 1897 he was promoted to Captain. He served in the Boer War, for which he was Mentioned in Despatches, and retired in 1905. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

LLOYD, Captain Gwion Llewelyn Bowen 5th Bn.

Son of Charles and Margaret Lloyd of Maesycrugiau, Carmarthenshire. Brother of Lieutenant Duncan Ian Bowen, 1st/5th Gurkha Rifles, I.A. (killed in action Aug. 14, 1915, at Gallipoli, aged 29 years). Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 11, 1915, aged 27 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

MONTGOMERY, Captain George Edward 5th Bn.

He was the ward of Katherine Twining of South Hayling, Havant, Hampshire. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 22 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

MOODY, Captain Ambrose 5th Bn.

Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

PEEL, Lieutenant Thomas Alfred Royal Army Medical Corps, attached 5th Bn.

Mortally wounded by a Turkish sniper on Aug. 19, 1915, while recovering wounded near Dead Man's House, Suvla. He was evacuated to Mudros on the Greek island of Lemnos, where he died on Aug. 24, 1915, at Mudros, Lemnos, Greece. Buried East Mudros Military Cemetery, Lemnos.

Other Ranks:

ALDRIDGE, Private James No.10452 5th En.

He was born and enlisted at Poole, Dorset. Killed in action in the vicinity of Kiretch Tepe Sin, Suvla, on Aug. 10, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ALLEN, Private Edwin No.12308 5th Bn.

Born at Parkstone, Dorset, and enlisted at Poole, Dorset, the son of Edwin James and Anna Martha Allen of "Oak Glen", Parkstone. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 23 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ALVES, Private Percival George No.10905 5th Bn.

Born at Glastonbury, Somerset, and enlisted at Taunton, Somerset, the son of George and Amy Jessie Alves of Glastonbury. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretch Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915, aged 22 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ANDERSON, Private John (see John SIM) No.11650 5th Bn.

ANDREWS, Private James John No.10872 5th Bn.

Born and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of William and Louisa Andrews of Blandford. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 18 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ANDREWS, Private William Stanley No.9878 5th Bn.

He was born at Salisbury, Wiltshire, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action south of Green Hill, Suvla, on the morning of Aug. 17, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ANGELL, Private Reginald John No.10712 5th Bn.

Born at Wallis Down, Hampshire, and enlisted at Wimborne, Dorset, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Angel of Chilbridge, near Wimbome. Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 7, 1915. He was one of four sons of Mr. and Mrs. Angel serving in the war, three of whom fell. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

ARCHER, Sergeant Arthur Patrick No.10044 5thBn.

Born at Belfast, Co. Antrim, and enlisted at Aldershot, Hampshire, the son of Mr. and Mrs. A.G. Archer of Aldershot. Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 8, 1915, aged 20 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

AYLES, Private Samuel No.12576 5th Bn.

Born at Dorchester, Dorset, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of Mrs. Sarah Ann Burt of Fordington. Husband of Annie M. Ayles of Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susaic Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 43 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BAGG, Private Harry No.10490 5th Bn.

Born at Winsworth, Dorchester, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, the son of Charles and Alice Bagg of Dorchester. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Winfrith, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 20 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BAGG, Private Wilfred Charles No.10562 "A Company, 5th Bn.

Born at Little Bredy, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of Walter James and Mary Jane Bagg of Lastridge Cottage, Warmwell, Dorchester. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 18 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial and on the Warmwell War Memorial, Dorset.

BARRETI, Private Albert George No.12252 5th Bn.

He was born at Bradpole, Dorset, and enlisted at Sherborne, Dorset Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BARTLET, Private William Albert No.10655 5th Bn.

Born at Kinson, Hampshire, and enlisted at Canford, Dorset, the son of Louisa Jane Bartlett of Kinson, Bournemouth, Hampshire. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Kinson. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretech Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BATITEN, Corporal Albert Victor No.13028 "B Company, 5th Bn.

Born at Chelsea, London, and enlisted at Battersea, London, the husband of Ethel Daisy Batten of Westcliff-on-Sea. He was mortally wounded by a Turkish sniper in the vicinity of Karakol Dagh, Suvia. Died of wounds in the Suvia sector on Sept. 13, 1915, aged 28 years. Buried Hill 10 Cemetery, Suvla.

BARREN, Corporal George Samuel No.10892 5th Bn.

Born at Preston, Yeovil, Somerset, and enlisted at Sherborne, Dorset, the son of J. and Temperance Batten of Leigh, Sherborne. Killed in action south of Green Hill, Suvla, on the morning of Aug. 17, 1915, aged 29 years. Buried Hill 10 Cemetery, Suvla. Name commemorated on the Leigh War Memorial, Dorset.

BEDWELL, Private Frederick Charles No.10196 5th Bn.

He was born at Ingleby, Greenhow, Yorkshire, and enlisted at Wareham, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BESENT, Private William Kingsbury No.10429 5th Bn.

Born at Bryanston, Dorset, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of James K. and Ann Sarah Besent of Winterbourne, Kingston, Blandford. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Winterbourne. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 18 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BLANDFORD, Lance Corporal Samuel No.10289 5th Bn.

Born at Charlton, Ludwell, Wiltshire, and enlisted at Shaftesbury, Dorset, the son of Mrs. B. Blandford of Ludwell. Died on Sept. 22, 1915, on Malta, aged 19 years. Buried Pieta Military Cemetery, Malta.

BOOKER, Corporal Thomas No.12909 5th Bn.

He was born at Chipstead, Kent, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Died and buried at sea Oct. 2, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BOWERING, Private John Tom No.10486 5th Bn.

Born at Milborne St. Andrews, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of Charles and Alice Jane Bowering of Hewish, Milborne St. Andrews. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Milborne St. Andrews. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretch Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915, aged 23 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BRADFORD, Private Edward No.10657 5th Bn.

Born at Little Canford, Dorset, and enlisted at Canford, the son of William Bradford of Staplehill Farm, Wimborne, Dorset. Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 7, 1915, aged 20 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BRAGG, Private Walter No.10085 5th Bn.

He was born and enlisted at Bridport, Dorset. Killed in action between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 22, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BRIEN, Corporal William Joseph No.10099 5th Bn.

He was born at Newcastle, Monmouthshire, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretch Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BRIGHT, Private Charles No.10406 5th Bn.

Born at Bere Regis, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of John and Sarah Ann Bright of Bere Regis. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 21 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BRODRICK, Private Thomas Richard No.10511 5th Bn.

He was born at Chevnan, Folkestone, Kent, and enlisted at Sherborne, Dorset. Killed in action in the vicinity of Kiretch Tepe Sift, Suvla, on Aug. 10, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BROWN, Private Stanley No.10891 5th Bn.

He was born and enlisted at Loders, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BROWNSEA, Private Frederick Percy Victor No.12663 5th Bn.

He was born at Shapwick, Dorset, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset. Died on Oct. 12, 1915, on Malta. Buried Pieta Military Cemetery, Malta.

BUNGAY, Private George No.10106 5th Bn.

Born at Branksome, Dorset, and enlisted at Poole, Dorset, the son of Edward and Eliza Bungay of Upper Parkstone, Dorset. Husband of Caroline Bungay of Poole. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 30 years. Name commemorated on the Cape Helles Memorial.

BURDEN, Private Thomas John No.10879 "D" Company, 5th Bn.

Born at West Chaldon, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of Henry and Elizabeth Burden. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 19 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

BURGESS, Private Frederick No.10285 5th Bn.

Born and enlisted at Wareham, Dorset, the son of Thomas and Maria Burgess of Wyatt's Lane, Wareham. Died of wounds Aug. 18, 1915, at Alexandria, Egypt, aged 22 years. Buried Chatby War Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria.

BUTTER, Private William Charles Frederick No.14908 5th Bn.

He was born and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset. Died Jan. 24, 1916, on the Greek island of Imbros. Buried Lancashire Landing Cemetery, Helles.

CALLOW, Lance Corporal Frederick James No.10178 5th Bn.

Born at Kingsbury, South Petherton, Somerset, and enlisted at Sherborne, Dorset, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Callow of North Street, Stoke-under-Ham, Somerset. Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 8, 1915, aged 29 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CANNINGS, Sergeant Charles Henry No.8380 5th Bn.

He was born at Fullerton, Andover, Hampshire, and enlisted at Wimborne, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CARPENTER, Private Frederick Alfred No.9919 "C" Company, 5th Bn.

Born at Orford, Suffolk, and enlisted at Weymouth, Dorset, the son of Caroline Carpenter of Weymouth. Died on Nov. 15, 1915, at Alexandria, Egypt, aged 23 years. Buried Chatby War Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria.

CARTRIDGE, Private William John No.10448 5th Bn.

Born and enlisted at Poole, Dorset, the son of William and Eliza Cartridge of Poole. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 21 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CHARLES, Corporal William James No.10863 5th Bn.

He was born at West Lulworth, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action in the vicinity of Kiretch Tepe Sirt on Aug. 10, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CHATWIN, Private Frederick Harold No.11803 5th Bn.

Born and enlisted at Birmingham, Warwickshire, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Chatwin of Alcester Road, King's Heath, Birmingham. Killed in action near Dead Man's House, Suvla, on Aug. 19, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CHILTON, Lance Corporal Joseph Vernon No.14378 5th Bn.

Born at Plaistow, Essex, an enlisted at Stratford, Essex. He was mortally wounded in the Suvla sector and evacuated to Alexandria, Egypt, where he died on Dec. 23, 1915. Buried Chatby War Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria.

CHURCHILL, Private Mark No.12624 5th Bn.

Born at Milton Abbas, Blandford, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of John and Elizabeth Churchill of Milton Abbas. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 18 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CHURCHILL, Private Victor No.10707 5thBn.

He was born at Milborne St. Andrews, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 22, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CLARK, Private Reginald Eli James No.9859 D Company, 5th Bn.

Born at Iwerne Minster, Dorset, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of James and Sarah Clark of Tower Hill, Iwerne Minster. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 26 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial and on the Iwerne Minster War Memorial, Dorset.

CLARKE, Lance Corporal Thomas Henry No.10699 5th Bn.

Born at Peshawar, India, and enlisted at Winchester, Hampshire, the son of Mrs. A. Clarke of Eastleigh, Hants. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Eastleigh. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretech Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915, aged 21 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CLEMENT, Private Arthur No.10339 5th Bn.

He was born at Wimborne, Dorset, and enlisted at Witchampton, Dorset. Killed in action between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 22, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CLEMENTS, Private George Albert No.11717 5th Bn.

He was born at Hackney, London, and enlisted at St. Pancras, London. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

COLLINS, Private Frederick No.9896 5th Bn.

He was born at Cary, Wareham, Dorset, and enlisted at Poole, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

COLLINS, Private William G. No.10148 5th Bn.

Born at Charminster, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of Mrs. E.M. Collins of Dorchester. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 29 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

COLLINS, Sergeant William John No.9854 5th Bn.

He was born at Somerstown, Middlesex, and enlisted at Boumemouth, Hampshire. Killed in action in the Suvla sector on Aug. 8, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

COOMBES, Private Walter No.10893 5th Bn.

Born at Tarrant Rushton, Dorset, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of Frank Coombes of Lime Kiln Cottages, Langton, Blandford. Killed in action during the unsuccessful assault on Kiretch Tepe Sirt, Suvla, on Aug. 9, 1915, aged 24 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

COOMBS, Private Henry George No.10632 5th Bn.

Born at Dublin, Co. Dublin, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset, the son of George and Rosaline Coombs. Died and buried at sea on Nov. 26, 1915, aged 31 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial and on the Langton Long Blandford War Memorial, Dorset.

COUSINS, Private Harry No.10181 5th Bn.

Born at Chariton, Horethome, Dorset, and enlisted Harry and Mary Cousins of Longburton, Sherborne. was living at Longburton. Killed in action during between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CROAD, Private Alfred George No.10074 5th Bn.

Born at Alton Pancras, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset, the son of Priscilla Croad of Alton Pancras. At the time of his enlistment he was living at Alton Pancras. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 22 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CROFT, Private James William No.10018 5th Bn.

Born at Chichester, Sussex, and enlisted at Blandford, Dorset. Died and buried at sea Sept. 17, 1915. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

CROSS, Private William James No.10210 5thBn.

He was born at Woolland, Dorset, and enlisted at Sturminster Newton, Dorset. Died on Sept. 22, 1915, at Alexandria, Egypt. Buried Chatby War Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria.

CURTIS, Private Albert No.10809 5th Bn.

He was born and enlisted at Lyme Regis, Dorset. Died of wounds on Sept. 4, 1915, on Malta. Buried Pieta Military Cemetery, Malta.

CUTLER, Private Edgar No.10369 5th Bn.

Born at Edminsham, Cranbourne, Dorset, and enlisted of Mrs. Annie Miles of Woodlands, Verwood, Dorset. was living at Woodlands. Killed in action during between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

DACOMBE, Private Cecil Albert No.10161 5thBn.

He was born at Sturminster Marshall, Dorset, and enlisted at Dorchester, Dorset. Killed in action during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, aged 21 years. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

He was laid to rest at Chideock (St. Giles) Churchyard on the afternoon of the following Thursday (Sept. 16). The breastplate on the lid of the coffin bore the inscription:

HARVEY, Private Walter Harry No.10681 5th Bn.

Born at Cumbton, Chamberlain, Salisbury, Wiltshire, and enlisted at Wimborne, Dorset, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey of Old Road, Wimborne. Killed in action between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 22, 1915. His brother-in-law also fell in the war. Name commemorated on the Helles Memorial.

HASKELL, Private Harry James No.10977 5th Bn.

Born Sept. 4, 1893, at Ampfield, Hampshire, the son of the late Harry Haskell, a painter on Sir George A. Cooper's Hursley Park Estate, and Anne (née Bone) Haskell of Ampfield. He was educated at Church Scholl, Ampfield. On Sept. 7, 1915, he enlisted in the 5th Dorsets at Blandford, Dorset, at which time he was living at Ampfield. He was unmarried. On Aug. 10, 1915, in the vicinity of Kiretch Tepe Sirt, Suvla, he was received a gunshot wound in the left leg, and was evacuated to Malta onboard H.M. Hospital Ship *Neuralia*. He arrived at Malta on Aug. 29. On the following day (Aug. 30) his leg was amputated above the knee, but tetanus set in shortly after and he died the following day at 6 p.m. (Aug. 31, 1915), aged 21 years. He was mortally wounded during the assault on Turkish trenches between Aire Kayak and Susak Kuyu, Suvla, on Aug. 21, 1915, and evacuated to Mudros on the Greek island of Lemnos, where he died on Aug. 24, 1915, aged 23 years. Buried East Mudros Military Cemetery, Lemnos.
