

MAKE A TANK FROM CARDBOARD



Cut the below pieces from paper and draw onto standard corrugated cardboard. Then cut the pieces from the cardboard and follow the instructions to build your tank.

Always ask for a grown ups permission to use any sharp instruments like scissors.

1. On the long TRACK pieces, peel away the top layer of the cardboard to reveal the corrugated inside.
2. Using your choice of adhesive (glue, Sellotape or washi tape) attach the edges together to make a loop.
3. Slide the TRACK INNER piece inside the loop to make the tank's treads. Attach in place.
4. Fold the MAIN BODY along the dashed lines and attach the edges, it will form a trapezoid shape.
5. Place one raw edge of the trapezoid inside the oval tread, attach in place. Repeat this with the other tread to create the base of your tank.
6. Fold the TURRET OUTER along the dashed lines.
7. Match the symbols on TURRET OUTER to TURRET WALLS and attach.
8. Attach this shape to the centre of the main body and make a hole where marked. A sharp pencil or a compass will do the trick.
9. Roll the paper GUN as tight as you can (wrapping it around a pencil can help start you off) and secure it. Slide this into the hole and attach.
10. Remove the top layer of cardboard from GUN like in step 1 and wrap around the end of GUN to create a raised edge.
11. And just like that, you have a tank made out of cardboard!
